Bible Story

One day, Moses was in the desert taking care of the sheep of his father-in-law. An angel of the Lord appeared to him in flames of fire, from within a bush. The strange thing was that the bush did not burn even though the fire kept burning. Moses was curious, so he got closer to the bush. That moment, God called, “Moses, Moses,” and told Moses to not get any closer. God told Moses to take off his shoes because he was standing on holy ground. So, Moses did. God told Moses that He saw the suffering of His people, the Israelites, who were slaves in Egypt. God wanted to set them free from slavery and bring them to a beautiful land.
