Focus Verse

“Thus saith the Lord God of Israel, Let my people go.” – Exodus 5:1



Bible Story

After Moses was chosen by God to help free the Israelites from slavery in Egypt, he went to talk to Pharaoh, the ruler of Egypt. Moses asked Pharaoh to let the Israelites go into the desert to worship God. But Pharaoh did not want to let the Israelites go. Pharaoh said that he did not know anything about this God they were talking about, so he was not going to let them leave. Once again, Moses asked for a short break for the Israelites to worship God. Instead, Pharaoh made things harder for the Israelites. Pharaoh told the slave masters to stop providing the Israelites straw, which they needed to make bricks. Now, the Israelites had to look for their own straw while still making the same number of bricks. This made their work much more difficult and tiring. The Israelite work leaders were upset. They blamed Moses and Aaron for making things worse.

Moses asked God why He had chosen him for the job if things were only going to get worse for the people. But though things were tough for the Israelites at that moment, God had a plan to rescue them from slavery and show Pharaoh His mighty power.
