## Focus Verse

“I will redeem you with a stretched out arm, and with great judgments.” – Exodus 6:6



## Bible Story

God told Moses, once again, that He would make Pharaoh let the Israelites go. After the Israelites had got mad at Moses for making their job harder, Moses needed comfort. God spoke to Moses and said to him that He is the Lord. He reminded Moses about the promise He made to give the Israelites the land of Canaan. God said that He heard the cries of the Israelites who were suffering as slaves to the Egyptians. He remembered the promise He made and wanted Moses to tell the Israelites that He is the Lord, and He will rescue them with His strong power. He said that they would become His people, and He would be their God. They would see Him as their Savior.

God talked to Moses and Aaron and gave them a message for the Israelites and for Pharaoh. God also told them to bring the Israelites out of Egypt. God told Moses to say everything He told him to say. Moses was still hesitant and unsure about his ability to speak clearly to Pharaoh. But even if we do not feel good enough, we must remember that God is in control and will give us all the things we need to do what He calls us to do.
