## Focus Verse

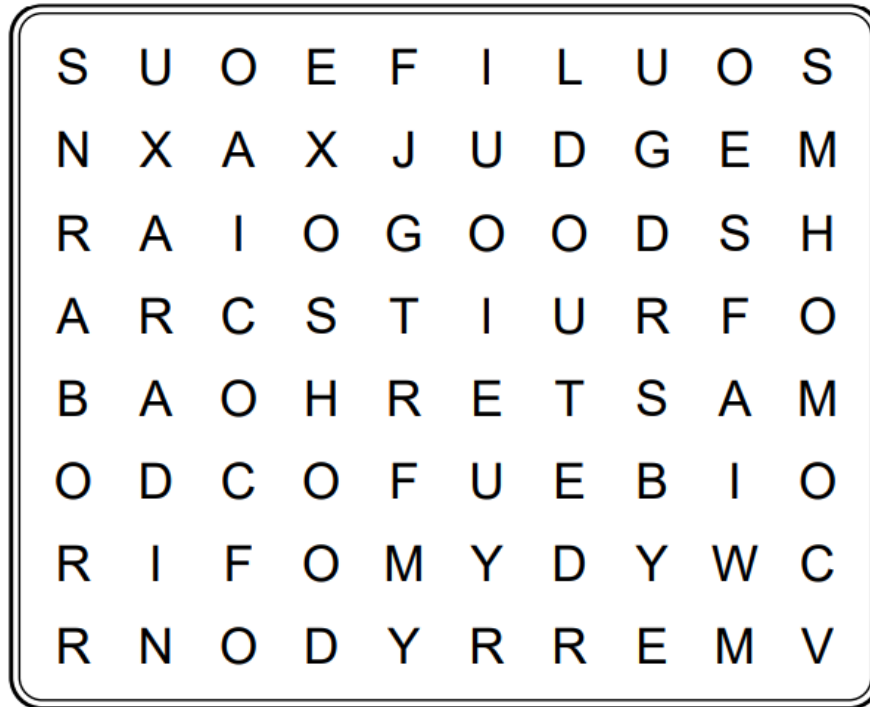
“For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also.” – Matt 6:21



## Bible Story
