


"And there shall nothing die of all that is the children's of Israel." - Exodus 9:4



Bible Story

Once again, God told Moses to talk to Pharaoh. Moses warned that if Pharaoh did not let the Israelites go, a plague would hurt Egypt's animals. The next day, as God had said, all of Egypt's animals died, but the Israelite animals were safe. And yet, Pharaoh did not listen to Moses' warning. Then, God told Moses and Aaron to take ashes from a furnace and throw them in the air. This caused the people and animals of Egypt to have painful bumps on their skin. Still, Pharaoh did not listen. God told Moses to warn Pharaoh that if he did not listen, a huge, destructive hailstorm would come to Egypt. People were told to bring everything valuable inside to protect them. Moses stretched out his hand to start the storm like God had told him, the storm wrecked everything outside, except the safe place where the Israelites lived, called Goshen.
