## Focus Verse

“And the Lord gave the people favour in the sight of the Egyptians.” – Exodus 11:3



## Bible Story

God told Moses that He was going to send one last plague to the Egyptians. This was the tenth plague. God promised that after this one, Pharaoh would let the Israelites go. Moses listened carefully as God explained the plan: Moses was to tell the Israelites to borrow gold and silver jewelry from their Egyptian neighbors. It may have appeared strange to Moses, but he did what God told him to do. Moses went to the Israelites and shared God's instructions, and the Israelites trusted him and did what God asked. Once again, Moses returned to the palace and told Pharaoh frightening news: at midnight, all the firstborn sons of the Egyptians would die. This would affect all the families of Egypt, both rich and poor. The firstborn of their animals would also die. But, in the midst of this tragedy, God assured Moses that not a single Israelite would be harmed. This powerful statement showed God's protection over His chosen people. Pharaoh's heart remained stubborn. But God was about to perform a great and final act that would make Pharaoh realize the cost of holding onto the Israelites.
