Bible Story

One day, Jesus told a parable about a landowner who went out and hired some people to work in his vineyard. He agreed to pay them a certain amount of money for the day's work. Later, the landowner went out again, finding more people looking for work, promising them fair pay. He did this a few more times during the day, hiring more workers each time. At last, the day was done, and it was time to pay the workers. But something interesting happened—the landowner paid everyone the same amount, no matter if they worked all day, or just for a little while. The people who started working early in the morning thought they would get more money because they worked longer, but they all received the same pay. So, they complained about this, but the landowner explained that he agreed to pay them a fair wage. Jesus said that the kingdom of God is like the landowner. This story teaches that God's love and generosity are not based on how much we do, and it reminds us that following God is more important than trying to be first or the most important in the world's eyes.
