
"And when I see the blood, I will pass over you." - Exodus 12:13



Bible Story

God told Moses and Aaron that the month they were in would be the first month of their new year. He gave them many instructions for the Israelites. God told them to pick a perfect, year-old lamb for each family. They would take care of it until the fourteenth day of the month. On that day, they would take some of the lamb's blood and put it on the sides and tops of the doorframes of their house. Then, they would roast and eat it. God also told them to eat bread without yeast for seven days. God said something important would happen that night, called the Passover. He would pass through Egypt and keep safe the houses with lamb's blood on their doors. This showed that those homes belonged to His people, and He would protect them. So, Moses told everyone what God said, and the people did exactly as God asked. They put the lamb's blood on their doors and had the special meal together. God warned the Israelites not to go out of their houses during the night of Passover. The Israelites are to keep the feast of Passover and the feast of unleavened bread from one generation to the next.
