Bible Story

It was time for the tenth and final plague. All the firstborns in Egypt died. The leader of Egypt, Pharaoh, was so sad because his own child was affected too. There was crying and sadness in every corner of the land. The king, Pharaoh, finally told Moses to take his people and leave, and go worship God. The Egyptians were so worried and scared, so they urged the Israelites to hurry up and go. The Israelites did what Moses told them and asked the Egyptians for silver, gold, and clothing. The Egyptians gave them all the things they asked for willingly because God was with the Israelites.

About 600,000 Israelite men, without counting their women and kids, left Egypt with their animals and belongings. Not just the Israelites, but many other people with their things went with them. Since the Israelites did not have time to prepare any food, they made flatbread called unleavened bread from their dough without yeast. The Israelites had been in Egypt for 430 years! At the end of these 430 years, on the exact day, God made all the Israelites leave Egypt. God told them to remember this day and honor it.
