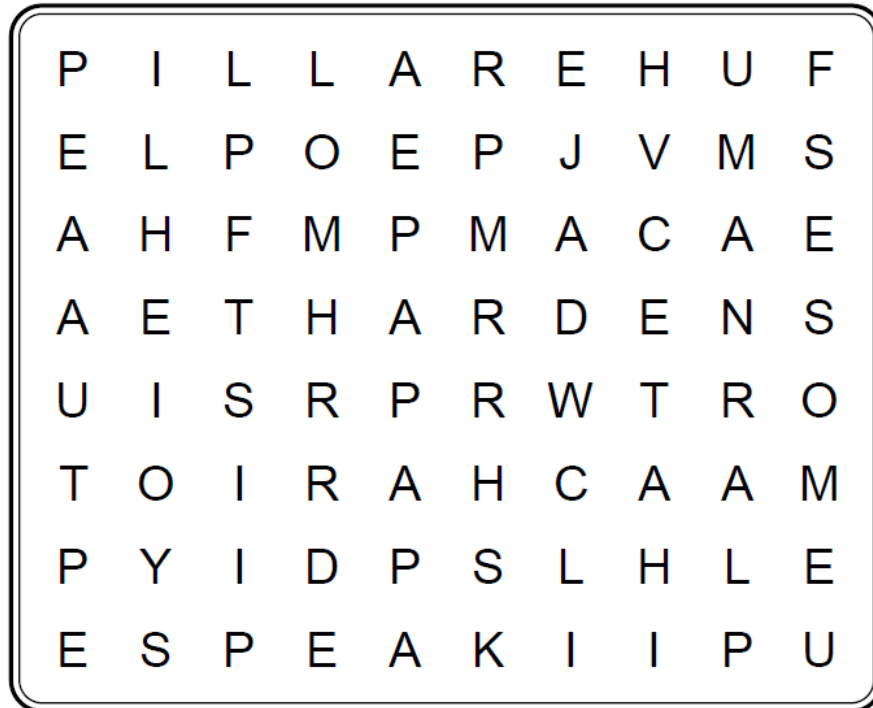
“And Israel saw that great work which the Lord did upon the Egyptians.” – Exodus 14:31



Bible Story
