Focus Verse

Bible Story

In this part of the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus talks about His followers, Christians, being the salt of the world. In the ancient world, salt was not only a seasoning for food, but it was also used to keep things from spoiling. Jesus is telling his followers that they should bring something special and valuable to the world, that is, a flavor of goodness, kindness, and righteousness.
