Bible Story

Jesus was getting ready to go into Jerusalem. He told two of his disciples to go get a donkey and a young donkey, which might sound a little strange, but it was actually a fulfillment of a prophecy from the Old Testament. The disciples did what they were told. They brought the donkeys to Jesus and put their clothes on them so that Jesus could sit. When Jesus rode into Jerusalem on the young donkey, people laid down their clothes and tree branches on the ground as a sign of respect and honor for Him. They rejoiced and shouted, "Hosanna to the Son of David!" Hosanna means "Save us!"

They wanted to show Jesus how much they loved and respected him. They believed that He was sent by God and could do great things. Now, the people did not realize that Jesus was not going to be the kind of King they were expecting. He did not come to be a Ruler who had a lot of control. Instead, He came to show them how to love each other and to show them the way to God. Even though the religious leaders, like the Pharisees, were planning to kill him, Jesus came to Jerusalem as the Messiah for everyone to see.
