Focus Verse

“God loveth a cheerful giver.” – 2 Corinthians 9:7



Bible Story

Jesus taught that when we do good things, like giving to the poor, we should not do it to show off or get attention from others. He said that if we give just to be praised by people, then that will be our only reward. Instead, Jesus wants us to give quietly and secretly, without making a big deal about it. This way, only God will see what we are doing, and He will reward us. Jesus used the example of giving to the needy. He said that when we give, we should not announce it loudly or let everyone know. Instead, we should do it so quietly that our left hand does not know what our right hand does. This means we should be humble and not seek attention or praise from others. God sure sees what we do in secret and will reward us for our kindness.

Jesus also explained that when we give to others, it will come back to us in a good way. He used the example of measuring, that is, if we give generously, we will receive generously in return. Jesus wants us to understand that being kind and giving to others not only helps them but also brings blessings back to us.
