“But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness.” – Matthew 6:33

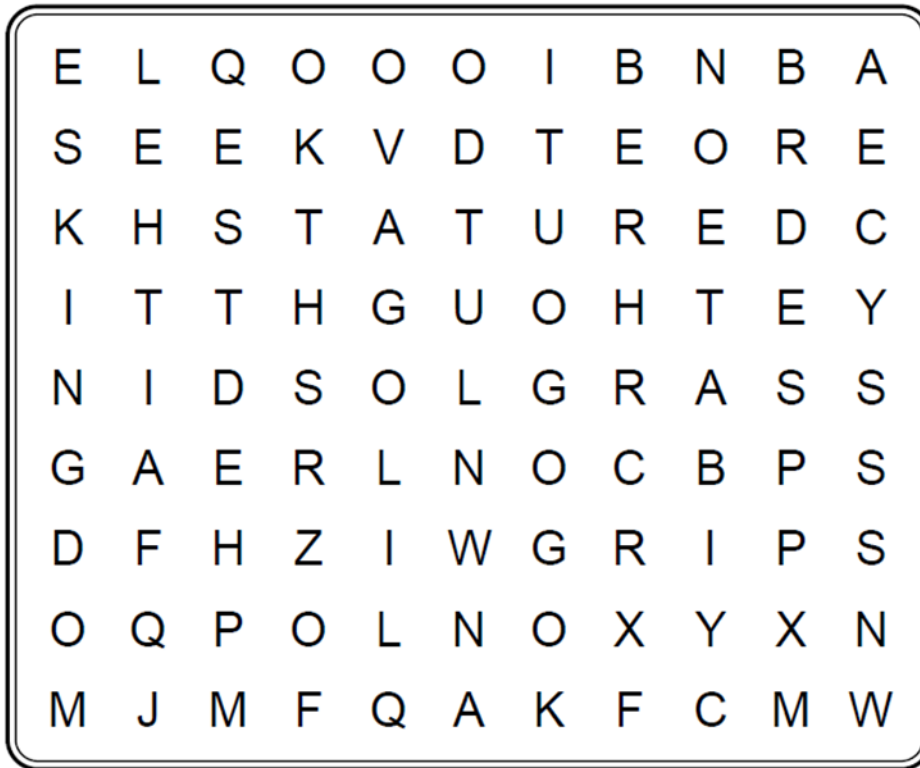


Bible Story
